*Ski Trip* - Saturday, 2/17 from 8:30 am –5:00 pm, at Butternut

- **Helmets:** Are required by BSA. All skiers and snowboarders must wear a helmet. Helmets are available for rental at Butternut for \$10.

Important Information

- **Campout:** Scouts to arrive at Camp Sequassen Loomis Lodge at 7:00pm. Have dinner at home or bring one with you. You will have to carry in your gear. Meals at the campsite include breakfast Saturday and Sunday as well as Saturday dinner. Cost for the campout is \$25 per person which includes the cabin fee and meals at Sequassen.
- **Ski Trip:** Bring money for lunch (or bag lunch) and snacks for Saturday.
- **Siblings and Parents** are invited to meet the troop at Butternut on Saturday morning at 8:30 a.m. (Siblings must be accompanied by an adult.)
- **Medical & Permission forms:** Each boy must have a *current* medical form on file with the troop, which includes a permission to treat. Be sure you also have a permission slip to participate in troop functions on file with Mr. Abrahamson. If you need to update any information, forms are available on our web site.
- **First time Skiers:** Are always welcome but are encouraged to take lessons or have a parent with them.
- **Lessons, rentals:** Are available to all, but you must pre-register for rentals. From the Ski Butternut website choose rentals from the top bar then choose daily rentals and complete the on line forms. Anyone under 18 must also have a parent or legal guardian sign a rental form which can be downloaded right under the on line form rental then scroll to the bottom of the page to print the rental form (Ski Butternut Ski or Snowboard Rental for Unaccompanied Children under age 18. Please print the forms and turn in with money).
- **Safety:** Safety, caution and courtesy are essential to all. All rules must be followed. Serious misbehavior could result in exclusion from the event.
- **Dress:** Dress warmly and appropriately (not expensive).
- **Snowboards:** May be used, but require greater care and concern for others.
- **Directions to Camp Sequassen:** Route 8 North to Exit 46 (Pinewoods Rd), turn right at end of ramp and first left. See sign on right, turning right into West Hill Rd. Loomis is on the North Side of the camp.
